SPACE HEATERS

When buying and installing a small space heater, follow these guidelines:

- 1) Only purchase newer model heaters that have all of the current safety features.
- 2) Choose a thermostatically controlled heater.
- 3) Select a heater of the proper size for the room you wish to heat.
- 4) Locate the heater on a level surface away from foot traffic.
