
Shredding procedure

• Each member is allowed to bring four boxes or bags of material, including CDs and credit cards.

• All material will be shredded on site.

• You do not need to remove staples, paper clips, hanging files, or black binder clips from materials.

• No three-ring binders.





Directions from Rock Energy to Universal Recycling

Option 1

- Head north on Kennedy Road.
- Turn right on Highway 14.
- Turn right and merge onto I-90 E/I-39 S toward Chicago.
- Take Exit 177, Highway 11 west toward Janesville/Avalon.
- Turn right onto Highway 11.
- Turn right onto Beloit Avenue.
- Universal Recycling is on the right side of street.
- Turn right into the company's first driveway.

Option 2

- Head south on Kennedy Road.
- Turn right onto Milton Avenue.
- Turn left onto Memorial Avenue.
- Turn right on Garfield Avenue.
- Turn right onto Racine Street.
- Turn left onto Main Street, which becomes Beloit Avenue.
- Universal Recycling is on the left side of street.
- Turn left into the company's second driveway.

Call 811 Before You Dig

Aug. 11 Date Serves as Safety Reminder

Rock Energy Cooperative hopes that Aug. 11 (8/11) will serve as a natural reminder for residents to call 811 before any digging project so underground utility lines can be marked.

The call and service are absolutely free.

When calling 811, homeowners and contractors are connected with their local onecall center, which notifies the appropriate utility companies of their intent to dig. If you'd rather submit the information online, visit the websites in the box to the right.

Professional locators are sent to the requested digging site to mark the approximate locations of underground lines with flags, spray paint, or both. If your planned work area is marked with underground utilities, do not dig there.

Striking a single line can cause injury, repair costs, fines, and inconvenient outages.


Every digging project, no matter how large or small,

warrants a call to 811. Installing a mailbox, building a deck, planting a tree, and laying a patio are all examples of digging projects that need a call to 811 before starting.

Wisconsin requires that the call to 811 be made three business days before the start of the project, while Illinois law specifies two business days.
