

Students Can Explore Leadership Potential

The conference, co-sponsored by the Wisconsin Electric Cooperative Association and UW-River Falls, is scheduled for July 14–16 at UW-River Falls.

Sai Karunamurthy and Arun Kumar, both students at Hononegah High School in Rockton, represented Rock Energy at the 2019 conference.

Rock Energy will pay for up to four high school students to attend the 2020 sessions. Applicants must be current freshmen, sophomores, or juniors who reside in the co-op's service territory and are children of co-op members.

Through a mix of workshop sessions, hands-on activities, and team-building experiences, participants will be exposed to a variety of real-life issues and given the opportunity to identify and explore their leadership potential.
