Learn more about programs, services, notices, and events.


F. Contact Information:

Energy Assistance Available For Low-Income Households

he Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) helps eligible low-income households pay for winter energy services. Fortunately, Rock Energy Cooperative works with WHEAP, which benefits about 230,000 Wisconsin households each year.

Weatherization Services

When you apply for energy assistance, the local agency also will see if you qualify for the Weatherization Assistance Program, which helps fund energy-efficiency and home improvement projects. If you are eligible for weatherization services, an energy auditor will look at your home to see what can be done to make it more energy efficient. Weatherization services differ with each home, depending on how it was built and its condition.
